

## How to Use a diskGO USB Flash Drive to Store and Access Files (Windows/PC)

- 1. Insert the flash drive into the USB port of a Windows computer (PC).
- 2. Browse to **'Computer'** (or **'My Computer'**) and locate the flash drive (typically labeled **'DISKGO'**). You can access 'Computer' by clicking the 'Start' icon (the Windows icon in the lower-left portion of your screen) and then selecting 'Computer.' It may take up 60-90 seconds for the flash drive to appear.
- 3. Locate the files and/or folders you wish to store on the flash drive.
- 4. Copy and paste or drag and drop the desired files on to the flash drive. If there are a large number of files or the files are large in capacity, it could take a few minutes (or longer) to complete the transfer. To avoid corruption, it is important to wait until the transfer is complete before proceeding to the next step.
- 5. Once the transfer is complete, remove the flash drive from the USB port.
