There are two types of Careline series telephone. The instructions to register and configure your SN6307 handset are different for those two types of Careline systems series telephone.

Operating range

This cordless handset operates with the maximum power allowed by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC). Even so, this handset and telephone base can communicate over only a certain distance - which can vary with the locations of the telephone base and handset, the weather, and the layout of your home or office. When the handset is out of range, the handset plays the voice prompt "Out of range" if any key is pressed. If there is a call while the handset is out of range, it may not ring, or if it does ring, the call may not connect well when you press M. Move closer to the telephone base, then press to answer the call.

During a call, if the handset is moved out of range, the call will end automatically, and you will hear a notification tone.
