Introduction

Rocstor introduces the HDMI to VGA + 3.5mm audio cable with a micro USB port for power. This adapter converts digital HDMI signals from devices like PlayStation or Blu-ray players into analog VGA video and R/L audio signals. It enables users to enjoy high-definition images and sound on traditional VGA monitors or projectors when watching movies or playing games.

This adapter provides solutions for digital entertainment centers, HDTV retail and show sites, HDTV, STB, DVD and projector factories, noise-sensitive areas, security concerns, data center control, information distribution, conference room presentations, and educational or corporate training environments.

HDMI (Male): Connect to HDMI sources, such as a DVD player or PC.



USB-A (Male): Connect to a host or power adapter to supply power to the adapter.



3.5mm Audio (Male): Connect to an amplifier or receiver to enjoy audio from HDMI sources.



VGA (Male): Connect to a display to view video from HDMI sources.

This HDMI adapter offers several features that ensure superior performance, including:

- Supports HDMI and USB input, VGA and R/L audio output.
- Supports HDMI resolution up to 1080p@60Hz and VGA resolution up to 1080p@60Hz.
- Converts complete HDMI signals into VGA video output.
- Supports 165MHz/1.65Gbps per channel (4.95Gbps total) bandwidth for HDMI input.

Note: If the HDMI source provides less than 1W of power, an external power supply is required. Otherwise, the product may not function properly due to insufficient power.
