The NPS BMPT Series Tables are designed for lasting strength and durability. With a little care, they'll stay looking their best for years.

Here are a few simple ways to preserve their condition:

- Maintain a relative humidity level between 30% and 40% to help protect the materials.
- Keep your table away from heat sources like radiators, heating vents, and wood-burning stoves.
- Avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight and extreme temperatures to preserve the finish.
- Wipe it regularly with a damp cloth to keep it looking its best.
- Clean up spills immediately to prevent damage, and for greasy stains, a mix of water and vinegar works well.
- When moving your table, always lift—never drag—to protect its structure.
- Avoid window-cleaning products, as their ammonia content can compromise the finish.
- While our tables are built for lasting stability, we recommend an annual check to ensure all screws remain securely in place.

To protect the powder-coated steel legs, avoid harsh cleaners or abrasive materials, as they can wear down the finish and cause fading or chipping. Additionally, exposure to extreme temperatures can weaken the coating, making it more prone to cracking and peeling.
